

Large Year-End Displays

Hanging lots of work at once can be taxing on teachers and on the hallway. Year-end units, project-based learning plans, or writing celebrations call for big displays that often flow much further than bulletin board boundaries. Tackle major exhibitions with this easy wall adaptation.

Step 1: Roll butcher paper to fit the height of the wall.

Step 2: Use bulldog clips to clip paper to the wall-bound rail of a drop ceiling.

Step 3: Slightly overlap adjoining paper, and glue in place with hot glue.

Step 4: Affix edges and the bottom to the wall with sticky tack or hot glue.

Step 5: Attach student work directly onto the hanging paper.
