

Student Work Displays

Use a variety of display options for student work to keep the focus where it should be — on the amazing pieces your students create! Try these ideas for end-of-year displays or prepare for the fall by gathering supplies before students arrive.



Hang laminated 12x12 scrapbook paper and attach clothespins with student names. The attractive background can stay all year while the work changes. Spice it up with different paper for different seasons. Look for sales this summer and hang a wall for fall.



String clipboards on a tight line by running cord through the clip on each clipboard. Use a couple lines to avoid overloading. Add student names to the clips and background paper to keep the display fresh and attractive.



Stick removable hooks to hall walls and use book rings through clear page protectors to display student work. A laminated name tag above work encourages ownership, and the rings can keep a portfolio all year.
