

## Marker Saver

Reuse markers left over at the end of the school year. Put uncapped markers tip-down in a container with water. It is okay if they are dry! Place all the like-colored markers together and let them soak. The water will draw into the soft marker material, creating easy-to-manage watercolors. Use them in place of watercolor trays for simple painting without the fuss.

Bonus! The longer they sit, the brighter colors become, so leave them over the summer and just freshen the water in the fall. You'll have watercolors ready to go.
